Cancer Tips

Cancer is to a large extent avoidable. Many cancers can be prevented. Others can be detected early in their development, treated and cured.

Even with late stage cancer, the pain can be reduced, the progression of the cancer slowed, and patients and their families helped to cope.

Effective Advocacy Strategies: Cancer Advocacy Organization 3 level approach

- Health Facility Practitioners /patient at hospitals and communities
- Advocate for effective treatment and support for patient- centered health care "struggle" on behalf of every patient
- Ensure that providers and others and stakeholders adopt national cancer health policy

Perspective of a policy maker on the role of Cancer Advocacy

- People emerge as leaders because they decide to take an action to change the status quo!
- Advocacy in cancer policy is crucial and it's the role of everyone
- Advocacy should be well structure and evidence-based
- Effective targeted communication
- Advocacy for realistic change
- Advocates are important partners to the government in cancer control

Exercise Also Improves Functioning of Cancer Survivors

- Effects of Exercise on Breast Cancer Patients and Survivor: A Meta-Analysis
- 717 breast cancer survivors in 14 randomized controlled trials
- Summary: Physical activity led to significant improvements in:
 - quality of life
 - physical functioning
 - peak oxygen requirements
 - reduction in fatigue

Way Forward

- Continue awareness campaigns with more involvement of civil society and community workers
- Roll out of breast cancer and cervical cancer screening in all districts
- Strengthen the community check up at primary health care level
- Improve diagnostic capabilities Imaging and Laboratory including new diagnostic techniques
- Chemotherapy in referral hospitals and later in provincial hospitals

Way Forward

- Human Resources for Cancer: all domains
- Have a National Center of Excellence: Referral center with advanced C & T of cancers
- Establishment of a Radiotherapy Center
- Establishment of hospitals and population based cancer registries
- Continue on Cancer Related Research
